We are in the process of expanding our music department at St Mark's, Hamilton Terrace and are seeking to appoint Alto (male or female) and Bass choral scholars for the academic year 2020-21. Scholars are required to be in attendance for the Sunday morning rehearsal and service each week, along with major festivals throughout the year. If we enter lock-down at any point, scholars will be required to produce a recorded weekly motet and hymn/movement of a mass for online Sunday services. The scholarship fee for the academic year 2020-21 will be £2400, paid throughout the year in monthly instalments. If starting later than September this will be paid pro-rata. Applications for choral scholarships are welcomed from enthusiastic singers who are currently in secondary or tertiary education, or who are already working in the professional scene, and want to develop their skills and contribute to the musical life of the church. There will be a maximum of 4 scholarship holders in the choir at any given time.
